**FULL TWO-YEAR WARRANTY ON WINCHESTER FIREARMS MANUFACTURED BY U.S. REPEATING ARMS COMPANY**

**FROM U.S. REPEATING ARMS COMPANY TO YOU** — This warranty is extended by U.S. Repeating Arms Company to the original purchaser and any succeeding owner within the two (2) year warranty period and applies to products purchased from any authorized Winchester firearms dealer in the United States or Canada.

**WHAT WE DO** — If your Winchester brand firearm fails because of a manufacturing defect or material or workmanship within two (2) years after the date of original retail purchase, we will repair it without charge to you. Parts and labor are included. If we are unable to repair your firearm, we will replace it with another or we will refund the original purchase price to you.

**HOW TO OBTAIN SERVICE** — An international network of U.S. Repeating Arms Company Authorized Service Centers for Winchester Firearms has been established to assure you of fast and efficient service if a warranty problem occurs. The U.S. Repeating Arms Company Authorized Service Centers for Winchester Firearms and U.S. Repeating Arms Company Product Service Department addresses at the printer are attached. Only the U.S. Repeating Arms Company Authorized Service Centers and the U.S. Repeating Arms Company Product Service Department are authorized to make repairs within the scope of this warranty without charge. To expedite the return of your firearm we encourage you to send it to the nearest listed U.S. Repeating Arms Company Authorized Service Center for Winchester Firearms.

You will be required to establish your date of purchase to receive warranty service. PLEASE BE SURE TO KEEP YOUR DATED SALES SLIP, CREDIT CARD RECEIPT, CANCELED CHECK, A COPY OF THE FIREARMS TRANSACTION RECORD (447), OR OTHER DEFINITIVE DATED PROOF OF YOUR DATE OF PURCHASE.

**WHAT IS NOT COVERED** — This warranty does not cover the cost of repairs to your firearm or its replacement when damage is unrelated to defects in material or workmanship, nor does it cover wear and tear or unreasonable use or abuse by you including (but not limited to) failure to provide proper care or maintenance, alteration not authorized by U.S. Repeating Arms Company. Damage through use of improper ammunition or barrels damaged by obstructions. U.S. Repeating Arms Company reserves the right to inspect the product prior to making any adjustment covered by this warranty. This warranty does not apply to products purchased outside the United States or Canada nor does it apply to products purchased in either the United States or Canada but not used in the United States or Canada. IN NO EVENT SHALL U.S. REPEATING ARMS COMPANY BE LIABLE FOR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES. ALL WARRANTIES, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING THE IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, ARE IN EFFECT ONLY FOR THE DURATION OF THIS WARRANTY. ALL SUCH WARRANTIES TERMINATE WHEN THIS WARRANTY TERMINATES. SOME STATES, HOWEVER, DO NOT ALLOW LIMITATIONS ON HOW LONG AN IMPLIED WARRANTY LASTS, OR EXCLUSIONS OR LIMITATIONS OF INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES, SO SUCH LIMITATIONS OR EXCLUSIONS MAY NOT APPLY TO YOU. These instructions are designed to assure you of the best possible service. If for any reason you should have to return the firearm, please use extreme caution and make certain that it is UNLOADED. Please return the complete firearm.

1. Package the firearm securely to prevent damage in transit.
2. Ensure that a letter is securely and obviously attached to the firearm. This letter should include your full name, address and telephone number where you may be reached both during normal business hours and at your residence, and include a thorough description of the problem that you encountered with your firearm so that we may make proper repairs. Please make your letter as clear as possible (using diagrams, if desirable), please write or print legibly or have the letter typed, or if you prefer you may call U.S. Repeating Arms Company at the number listed below.
3. Include your prepaid insurance and parcel post or UPS receipts with your instructions for repair. You will be reimbursed for documented shipping and insurance costs directly from the Warrenter's plan.
4. Please include a photocopy of your proof of date of purchase (sales slip, credit card receipt, canceled check, 447, etc.) and include in your letter the date that the firearm was originally purchased at retail. Do not send the original proof of purchase as the copy sent will be retained.
5. If you live in the United States, send your firearm to one of the U.S. Repeating Arms Company Authorized Service Centers for Winchester Firearms (or send it to U.S. Repeating Arms Company, 275 Winchester Avenue, P.O. Box 30-100, New Haven, Connecticut 06511). If you live in Canada, send it to one of the U.S. Repeating Arms Company Authorized Service Centers in Canada (or send it to U.S. Repeating Arms Company, 275 Winchester Avenue, P.O. Box 30-100, New Haven, Connecticut 06511).
